FAQs

Q: What is Deaf Camp?

Deaf Camp offers immersive day camp experiences for ages 18 months through high school seniors. Open to Deaf, hard of hearing, oral students, siblings, and hearing children with Deaf parents, the camp focuses on improving communication through ASL, problem-solving, and team-building. Each day includes age-appropriate adventures like creating visual stories, electives, games, and field trips. For more information, visit thedeafcamp.com.

Q: What is Deaf Kids Connect?

A: Deaf Kids Connect is a ministry dedicated to connecting Deaf and Hard of Hearing children and their families with the love of Jesus. We equip, support, and mentor parents to share God's love and raise disciples through ASL. For more information, visit our website at deafkidsconnect.com.

Q: Do I need to register for evening activities?

A: Yes, please register for the evening events to ensure we can plan food and materials.

Q: If I register for Deaf Camp, am I automatically enrolled in the evening activities?

A: No, these are separate programs, and each requires its own registration. Be sure to register for both if you plan to participate in both Deaf Camp and the evening activities.

Q: What is the Monkey's Treehouse meetup?

A: Families with kids ages 0-5 are invited to meet at Monkey's Treehouse (91 Seaboard Ln #103, Brentwood, TN 37027) on Thursday morning for a casual gathering. This is an option for families without daytime Deaf Camp programming. Free Play is \$15 per child with 2 free adult passes per child.

Q: Can we join just for the evening activities?

A: Yes! All families with Deaf children are welcome, whether or not they participate in Deaf Camp during the day.

Q: Is childcare provided during the evening activities?

A: Evening activities are designed for families to enjoy together. For sessions specifically geared toward parents, we will provide childcare.

Q: Can I bring my child under 2?

A: Yes! Children under 2 are welcome to join you throughout the entire event. Feel free to include them in activities or care for them as needed.
